

## Review of: "Weathering changes – livelihood adaptation to weather shocks in rural India by disadvantaged social groups"

I appreciate the author for presenting this interesting work. I think the overall quality of the manuscript is decent as it contributes to the current knowledge on climate change impacts on migration specifically among the disadvantaged social groups. Below are some revision proposals which might be considered in the final version of the manuscript:

- It is better to focus on 'migration' instead of 'livelihood adaptation' in the title, as the main focus of the analysis is on migrations.
- Please clearly define what type of migration you are referring to as it is not clear enough in the present format. This
  might be included in the title as well
- Please avoid using abbreviations in the abstract. Also, not all abbreviations in the manuscript text are defined the first time you used them. Please revise them.
- Some citations have a comma after the authors' names while others do not. Also, they are not well-ordered when coming together. Please use a united format for all.
- Please provide references for the third paragraph of the introduction.
- · Please explain well why you chose social networks for your analysis and not other possibly influential factors.
- You have mixed the discussions with the conclusion section which is not advised according to my view (if you intend to
  do so please change the title of the section). Therefore, having a separate discussion section is very advisable, as your
  results section mostly lacks discussions.
- You have provided general discussions around your main results only, while it could be more interesting to bring causality discussions around all (as much as possible) your analysis outcomes.

Again I appreciate your interesting piece of work and wish you success in future endeavors.
