

Review of: "The Choice of Breeding Objectives and Selection Criteria Decided by Breeders of Various Goat Breeds and Factors Influencing Them"

This article provides useful information on the factors influencing the choice of breeding objectives and selection criteria decided by breeders of various goat breeds in the UAE. It is generally appropriately organized, carried out, and written; however, there are some points that should be corrected or clarified.

Title: I suggest "Factors Influencing the Choice of Breeding Objectives and Selection Criteria Decided by Breeders of Various Goat Breeds in the UAE"

Abstract

L1-2: "...breeding program. A questionnaire was therefore prepared and distributed among breeders of various goat breeds in the Abu-Dhabi Emirate to examine their breeding..."

L3-4: "A total of 293 different goat herds with a total of 49911 heads were finally investigated. The results suggest that goat breeders in the UAE keep goats mainly..."

L6-7: "Factors that influenced breeders' decisions on breeding objectives were goat breed, region, property type – production system, and herd size."

L1: Please use “fur” instead of “fiber” throughout the text

L1: “adaptive” instead of “adaptable”

L2: “production” instead of “manufacturing”

L3: “increases” instead of “increasing”

L4: “...in the Abu-Dhabi Emirate in 2016, and represented more...”

L6-7: “This is observed since the majority of goat breeders in the UAE do not raise goats for profit, but as a hobby and as a source...”

L12-13: What do you mean? Please rephrase

L14: “by taking” instead of “take”

L15: “...to derive economic values to quantify...”

L17: “the genetic improvement of livestock” instead of “genetically improve livestock breeds”

L18-19: “Traditionally used economic values often fail to take into consideration subjective traits...”

L20: “that are not easily” instead of “being not easy to be”

L2: “...breeders to select from multiple-choice questions [12]. For animal breeders, this process involves the analysis of breeders’...”

L4: “including” instead of “this includes”

L5-7: What is your point?

L8-9: “...to breeders for the improvement of productivity of their animals and the development of an applicable genetic improvement program.”

L10: “...might affect their decisions in the UAE.”

Study area: Please add a reference at the end of the paragraph.

Sample selection

L5: “observed” instead of “found.”

L7: “On the other hand,” instead of “However,”

L8: “random place.”

L10: "...while mixed farms are allowed..."

L11: "...found; only with goats or mixed..."

L12 - P4, L1: "...as medium and more than 350 heads as large herds."

Breeders interview

L1: Please delete "and tested."

L3: "originated from the same herd" instead of "were homegrown."

L5: "...of the owner. Breeds that were..."

Statistical analysis

L1: "Survey data was statistically analyzed using the Chi-square test of the FREQ procedure in SAS/STAT [19]."

L2: "criterium."

Breeding objectives

L2: "rear" instead of "are breeding."
