I hope that through my feedback I can help make your manuscript even more valuable to the community.

Your approach to equip buses with GPS transponders is an adequate means to increase the performance and acceptance of public transport. This also brings me to a first point of criticism.

Your manuscript reads more like a technical paper in the current version. It lacks an overview of the current state of research and development. Some of the literature cited is outdated and, in my opinion, does not reflect developments in this area over the past 24 months.

Also, your explanations above the hardware level remain very vague. In what form is the real-time data stored? How are failures or even implausibilities handled?

There are a lot of things that could be mentioned here, but I hope that these essential points will help you.
