This is the real paper, published 2 years ago:

The only sections Dai-Long Ngo-Hoang wrote by himself are the discussion and the conclusion, which are grandiloquent, unaccurate and not well written.

Plagiarism is a shame and an offence for all the scientific community. Obviously this paper has to be rejected, and the preprint that appears in Dai-Long Ngo-Hoang researchgate profile has to be removed.

To finish, I have to say that I had to give this paper a star because it is the only way in which the system will let me post my comments. It doesn't deserve anything but rejection.
