The methodology is commended for its positivistic approach and clear presentation but could enhance transparency in sampling. The model assessment is thorough, with proper justification, but could benefit from more discussion on practical significance. Results and discussion effectively present and discuss outcomes, but additional exploration of gender influence and model changes is recommended. The conclusion is strong in summarizing outcomes and delineating theoretical and practical implications. However, explicit discussions on model modifications and limitations are needed. Overall, the article contributes significantly to understanding intrapreneurial behavior in Malaysian public universities, with a rating of 4.2/5.
