- 5. Why did the author choose non-probability sampling design for a scientific study? There should be a rationale for such decision.
- 6. The longitudinal data ranges from 2010 to 2022, is there a rationale for this? why not data ranging say from 2000 to 2022?
- 7. Data analysis method utilized multiple regression techniques that do not take into consideration the lagged effects of the independent variables on the dependent variable, why not econometric models such as ARDL and VAR?
- 8. Are the correlation results in line with your theoretical thinking in the study?
