The calculation of the sample size appears to lack clarity, which could be improved for better reproducibility and validity of the findings. Furthermore, it seems that the study's generalizability may be limited due to potential issues with external validity. It may be beneficial to consider conducting a follow-up study with a larger sample size to build upon the insights gained from the current research. Moreover, the article's excessive length could potentially hinder readability and comprehension, suggesting a need for concise and focused presentation of information. Additionally, the inclusion of too few references may limit the breadth and depth of the literature review, thus weakening the theoretical framework and overall robustness of the study.
