Some comments and suggestions about this manuscript are as follows:

- 1. In the abstract part of the study, used software, E-views, may be removed from the text for a more professional appearance.
- 2. Please avoid the use of abbreviations in the abstract part of the study, e.g., CBN, it is not clear, I suppose it refers to the Central Bank of Nigeria, but just guess.
- 3. Line 6: layoff off (repeating use mistakenly).
- 4. Please include the study's structure, i.e., organization, at the end of the introduction.
- 5. No need to use any sources for your results' demonstrations, e.g., Figure 1.
- 6. In Table 1, include some notations like *, indicating whether statistics are significant or not, and besides, utilize at most three decimals for results' presentations.
- 7. In Table 3, put the statement "Null Hypothesis: No Long-run Relationship" below Table.
- 8. In such a study, descriptive statistics are needed to have a better understanding of the nexus between variables.
- 9. As far as is understood, all the variables are in the log-form, please carefully check the interpretation of coefficients.
- 10. All variables should be defined in a clearer way.
- 11. Please check the results CUSUM of square statistics, as far as is seen, in some periods, the cumulative sum exceeds the area between the two critical bounds.
- 12. Where are *s in Table 6.
- 13. My words in the 11th comment are valid for Figure 6 too.
- 14. Conclusion part of the study could have been written more strikingly.
