On the one hand, comprehensiveness is not enough if a survey is to be provided. On the other hand, if a new method is to be proposed, the method must be described in more detail, more experimental results must be provided, and comparisons with the baseline method must be made, which is important to support the claims made in the paper.

Therefore, I suggest a major revision of the paper.
