Thank you for the opportunity to review this excellent article. My opinion is that it offers insight on a timely and crucial issue - online teaching - based on a sound methodology. It is well and clearly written. There is a typo ['Reliability and validity'] - end of first paragraph on Page 8. Overall, I strongly recommend this paper. My only suggestion would be to include, in the findings, some accounts (my guess is there were a few) about the technological tools that other pedagogical adjustments the interviewees learnt/adopted to enrich their teaching. It would reinforce the argument of the broadening of one's skills (3.2.4), and at the same time enrich the relevant bibliography about the 'side-benefits' that the overall challenging and negative experience has had on all teachers' professional identities worldwide.
