

Review of: "Factors contributing to labour unrest at the garment factories in Bangladesh: A cross-sectional study"

The paper aims to understand the factors that contribute to labor unrest in Bangladesh. I have a couple of comments:

1. The coverage of the variables is very decent, however I would have expected a more compelling and critical overview of the literature, not only in terms of existing research on Bangladesh, but existing research in general. The role of the trade unions may have been particularly explored, because one of the key findings is on this aspect.
2. The selection of respondents is not super clear. Has any stratification been applied to secure representativeness of the sample?
3. The multilevel regression approach may be suitable, but differences across models potentially deserve more attention, as well as common findings across models.
