The topic addressed in the paper is of great relevance and importance. The paper is well structured and the supporting bibliography is extensive and well documented. However, the concepts expressed are redundant and repetitive in some places and the goals of the paper seem somewhat ambitious (eradication of vector-borne diseases in Indonesia). Nevertheless, the work has the merit of drawing attention to a topic of great importance, especially in relation to the geographical area to which it refers, where the one-health approach for the management of vector-borne diseases is still not given much attention by local policies.
