- Some information lacks direct citations to specific studies or sources, which could impact the credibility of the
  information presented. Providing more direct references for each statement or claim would strengthen the review's
  authority.
- 4. At times, the review uses complex language and scientific terminology without sufficient explanation, potentially making it less accessible to readers without a scientific background. Simplifying technical terms or providing explanations could improve comprehension for a wider audience.
- 5. Some statements lack adequate context or explanation, such as the mention of HPV transmission through water without supporting evidence or clarification, which might leave readers with unanswered questions.
