Page 1, Keywords: Another keyword could be: "mitigation strategies," because this will catch the attention of a wider audience, hopefully also of policy makers.

Page 2, 2nd paragraph: Törnqvist & Blum, 2024 //no dot after "Blum"//

Page 4, end of 2nd paragraph: "... writing position papers and research reports." //"papers," plural//

Page 4, 3rd line from bottom: ... the initiative. This includes the presentation of instructive case studies. //The presentation of instructive case studies may be necessary in order for the peer groups to learn more about the tool box available when dealing with land subsidence.//

Page 5, 1st line of last paragraph: "... mitigation. In ... //spacing before "In" is missing//
