- In the abstract, authors need to explain more results and reduce the introduction.
- Introduction was written in not usual format, please recreate in a single section without sub-sections as well as explain about "research problem" clearly.
- You did social research used mixed method, but the number of respondents was too little without scientific reason. I think you need to address the detail about sampling method and how to choose your respondents.
- Method and results are so confusing because the separation about two sections not clear.
- There is no proper discussion to support the results.
- Conclusion need to rewrite.
