First, why Bodoland? Do the authors expect something different in this region as compared with the previous studies? Please provide a well articulated context.

Second, What to we already know? Unless we review the existing studies, we cannot have the idea of novelty. Please review the study.

Third, it needs to dig deeper with the massive information that it is based on and offer new insights. There is we do not know the impact of education, age, marital status, family structure or the type of business on the challenges and their perception regarding the contribution. Use statistical and econometrics tool to explore various relationships.
