The manuscript by Muhamad Hanif Rawi, titled 'Exploring the Significance and Medicinal Potential of Rubus fraxinifolius: A Review of Ragimot Wildberry,' sparks genuine interest.

Firstly, I suggest a slight modification of the title.

In the Introduction section, the authors clearly outline the review's objective, providing a distinct perspective on the uniqueness of this plant species found in the endemic zone of Borneo.

Regarding the 'Nutritional Composition' part, I believe integrating the antioxidant activity and a distinct phytochemical screening of different parts of the plant, comparing them with Ragout Wildberry, would be necessary to enhance the review's information and make it more relevant.

As for the 'Efforts on Cultivation' section, I find it well-formulated, serving as an introduction to new aspects related to the cultivation of Ragimot.

Finally, the references used are mostly recent, reflecting the richness of the review in new information.

In my view, the acceptance of the review is possible with some corrections.
