2. Given the presence of control and experimental groups, it is imperative to conduct and elucidate normality and homogeneity tests for both sets.
3. Expert validation alone is insufficient for both the instruments measuring students' knowledge and those assessing students' attitudes. It is crucial to perform additional validity and reliability tests for both types of instruments.
