The abstract briefly reflects the content of the article, with clear explanations.

The introduction accurately describes what the authors wanted to investigate. Previous research is mentioned with citations. Working hypotheses, purpose, objectives and scope. The general working method was described.

Method. Chapter 2 mentions the papers that helped to make the case study and influenced the outcome.

In Chapter 3, the working methods, the technologies used, the data collection process are presented. The explanations are clear and to the point.

Results. Chapter 4, Findings and Discussion presents the results of the study. They are structured in order, with explicit figures. Isovist analysis and visibility graph is illustrated by representative figures.

The analyzes performed are appropriate for this study.

Implications of this study for safety concerns particularly for women and children are presented.

Conclusions. Chapter 5 makes recommendations based on the results of the study. These recommendations can make markets safer for visitors and shoppers.

Chapter 6, conclusions demonstrate that Isovist and VGA can be used as a way to assess visibility based on real-time

vision and human vision, respectively.
