The topic of the paper is very interesting because it addresses some gender issues in financial services access.

The authors need to specify the category of women (in rural areas or in the big cities) and also the agribusiness sector targeted by this study. Indeed, women in the big city who have good jobs with salaries may also be involved in some agribusiness activities, and therefore will not face most of the barriers found in this study.

In addition, depending on the agricultural sector concerned by the business (crop, vegetable, or livestock production), it can be more or less difficult to access financial services.

I also think that the barriers listed can be revised to consider only barriers that are gender specific.

Lastly, the study methodology could have been more statistical (meta-analysis).
