The paper have a subject of high actuality, treating a very serious health problem of our days. The paper cover a high amount of information, from 71 scientific articles, presenting the antibacterial effect of the mentioned species on very resistant strains, but also their secondary benefit on the infections secondary effects. This could be one of the advantage of using the products based on herbals.

The language is fine.

Although the review articles are longer, the information regarding the antibacterial effects of the medicinal plants that are the subject of paper should be more organized. I suggest to the authors to use tabels to organize some information, in such way to can more easily read and find infos.

Also a comparative discussion on the use of these plants could be very useful for readers.

I think with minor modifications the paper could be published.

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
