The paper describes generic competencies in a given university, but it could be of many, at least, Latin-American universities.

It goes on over common places, and does not give new information. In this sense, its main contribution is to systematize information, rather than producing new knowledge.

Tables 1 and 2 should be only one. It is very difficult to compare the information, which is critical to understand the conclusions.

Although the paper is written in English, references are in Spanish. Considering the paper intends to compare competencies in Latin-American and Europe, there should be references to European (not only Spaniards) authors.
