Though the paper is structured well, the sampling framework is not detailed ... just mentioning a sample size of 500+ is too generic and vague and does not contribute to specific findings ... questions like who is a health care professional? What is their nature of work? What leads to burnout? need attention.

Answering these basic questions can bring the right direction for further perusal of the paper.

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
