- 1. There is no correspondence between the title and the abstract. It is recommended that the abstract in general directly contains 3 major things, namely the purpose of the paper, how a paper is made and the conclusion of the paper.
- 2. The introduction does not state the condition of SMEs in Malaysia and the urgency of the need to write this paper in relation to the digital economy, and/or digitalisation.
- 3. There needs to be consistency in the use of words between "digitalisation" and "digitization". Because to my knowledge the two words have different meanings.
- 4. The preparation of research questions should be based on previous research gaps. The research question also does not include the word "Malaysia".
- 5. It seems like this paper is a conceptual paper, and there should be a method section that explains how the process of writing this conceptual paper.
- 6. In the literature review section, there is less discussion about the real conditions of SMEs in Malaysia related to the digital economy and or digitalisation and or digitisation.
- 7. I did not find the answer to the research question.

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
