The author of the paper predominantly draw upon their professional experiences as opposed to grounding their discussion in empirical research. While these insights are valuable, they are inherently subjective, often encapsulating the authors' personal perspectives and potential biases.

In Chapter 2, the expectation is to furnish the reader with comprehensive context on business and construction projects, essential for grasping the posed research questions and key discussion points. The chapter aims to navigate the subject matter, highlight the main characteristics of businesss and construction projects with sufficient thoroughness. However, this has not been fully achieved.

A robust foundation for the authors' claims would ideally be established through empirical data, illustrative case studies, or an extensive review of the literature, components that are noticeably absent. Incorporating such elements could enhance the substantiation of their viewpoints.

The conclusions drawn have the potential to exert a notable impact on the domain of project management education, particularly if the authors were to provide pragmatic recommendations. Such actionable insights could prove invaluable for professionals seeking to translate theoretical understanding into effective practice."
