I'm an experienced reviewer for a lot of journals but I've not reviewed for Qeios before and therefore do not know what standard of work usually makes it on to this platform. I am interested in Transitional Care and I am a graduate of public health nursing doctorate program.

- The academic reasons stated in the form are inadequate. The roles of the nurses are not clear as there may be a general discharge procedure across Europe. Topics such as carer education, medication explanation, information about the disease and coping with the disease should be explained in more detail.
- This study is important, but; needs development. The definitions are too general. for example; Return home Once Medically optimised and not requiring further support except basic mobility aids and/or suggesting lifeline etc, may warrant referral for home safety assessment
- What is the referral for home safety assessment
- What is the functional capacity? (Rehabilitation in Transitional Care Bed)
- How is the statistical analysis (validity and reliability) this paper?
- objective criterion in long-term care. For example, the level of addiction to bed
