Dear authors! Thanks for your contribution to this area and education.

I would like to start by clarifying some aspects I consider were not clear on the article:

1. Since introduction, a preference for NEST is remarked, and sometimes it looks like a personal view from the authors, because you don't consider enough studies or references to demonstrate that it is not your opinion. For example, when you use sentences like "While NESTs hold clear advantages".
2. In the "Advantages of NNESTs" part, specially the first two paragraphs, there is not enough literature to emphasize the ideas. Even if they are considered in the last paragraph, it is not clear at all.
3. Even if the article shows interesting results, it is not clear the way you get them. How did you find the variables?
4. Talking about the interviews, how did you follow the ideas to find the results? It is not clear the way you analyzed data and results.
