

Review of: "Facility Management Challenges of Public Educational Facilities in Nigeria"

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Potential competing interests: No potential competing interests to declare.

This manuscript addresses the need to further invest in facility management in Nigeria, also mentioning developing countries. It is not clear the use of the expression, forcing the reader to find more information.

I would suggest revising the title in terms of clarity and non-duplication of terms, also in the manuscript needing additional proofreading.

The abstract could better contextualize the manuscript, at the beginning, defining all abbreviations at first use (abstract as text). It is also important to include sociodemographic information, including gender.

Introduction section would gain in better interconnecting the content and updating references, with less separated paragraphs. There is also some difficulty in understanding the logic behind literature section and the headings.

Methodology section may rely on references to support the approach, also mentioning ethics and consent.

In the results section, some tables could be replaced by graphics, better translating the results.

I would suggest merging discussion (significantly expanded) with results, in order to more clearly understand its relevance.

A conclusions section including contextualization, methodology, findings, implications, limitations and prospects would contribute to improve readability.

To address more relevant international and updated references would be also important.
