Dear Authors, I read with interest this article about fears and obsessions related to COVID-19 influencing the vaccination status of people with diabetes. However, I would like to draw your attention to some missing features:

- Reasons why partially vaccinated people did not continue the vaccination programme are not explained (sometimes people had reactions due to the vaccine).
- There is no comparison with healthy people. It might be useful to assess whether fears and obsessions described in diabetic patients are common to non-diabetic people matched for social status, ethnicity and age.

However, I believe that this work is currently lacking certain elements (explained above) that could make it more complete.
