

Review of: "Demographic and Clinical Characteristics of Refugee Children Utilizing Healthcare Services of Türkiye (2021-2022): A Single-Centre Study"

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This article describes the characteristics of refugee children visiting health care services in Türkiye and explores the problems presented at a single center. It is commendable that in the era of a rising number of refugees, a study focusing on refugee children, who are the most common groups among refugees, was done. As most of the illnesses that children suffer from can be prevented, it is of utmost importance to know the prevalence of common illnesses and be prepared to manage the same at health facilities.

However, it is not quite clear why people visited the emergency department for routine screening. Also, intoxication has been mentioned as one of the findings, but it is not clear what type of intoxication was found among children.
