The manuscript is a review paper dealing with the activity of some essential oils against different antibiotic-resistant strains of bacteria. The manuscript is well written and, although the topic is not novel, it can be of interest for readers. Unfortunately, the list of references is not complete, and other papers dealing with the use of Origanum vulgare, Thymus vulgaris, Rosmarinus officinalis and Cinnamomum zeylanicum against bacterial species has not been reported.

Sub heading 1.2 line 13, The plural of "medium" is not "mediums", but "media"

S.h. 1.3, line 9 please, write the proper name per extenso; line 10 - "bacterial species" instead of "bacterial strains".

Other shortcomings are the lack of full stop after the initial of genera (i.e. C longa instead of C. longa) and the use of italics in writing species.
