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The article presents a new model to measure the productivity of software developers. The article needs improvements in writing:

- In the Introduction: add a paragraph with a summary of related work;
- In the last paragraph of the Introduction: present the article's organization;
- Add an opening paragraph in sections 3 and 4;
- Indicate a reference or show a study that indicates the validity of the statement in "Unnatural contributions can be detected through clustering techniques that analyze metrics such as commit time delta (CTD) and contribution size. For instance:", page 6;
- In Section 4, a figure helps to present the model;
- I recommend that the authors use a statistical method to test hypotheses.
