This study provides many valuable descriptions of a particular population. However, the article might be revised with the following taken into consideration.

- 1. More valuable findings could be obtained on the interelations between the observable phenomena.
- 2. The present form of the report is somewhat like a series of pictures of what the authors tried to look at. If the observations were richly based on objective data and statistical analyses were conducted in order to generate theoretical inferences, then the paper would have been sound in a scientific way.
- 3. The pictures are meaningful. Meanwhile, however, they make the paper look like a narration instead of a scientific report.
- 4. It seems strange to me that the headings are ended with ":". The authors may need to have a check of the format
