

## Review of: "Conditional Freezing, Flight and Darting?"

The manuscript by Trott et al. investigated conditional responses in fear conditioning experiments in rodents. This is a compelling and important study on potentially associative nature of flight responses observed under certain conditions in fear conditioning instead of freezing. This manuscript is nicely and clearly written. Four experiments with a number of controls were elaborately designed to resolve possible doubts. My only concern was the number of animals per group (n=8), which in my opinion is quite low as for behavioral studies, however authors have rational arguments for their decision.
