- 1. The first paragraph is difficult to read and does not orient the reader to the topic of the article. Perhaps provide a definition of an addiction research center or how it has evolved over time (as is written in the third paragraph).
- 2. The data provided within the "community out-reach follow-up services:" paragraph is very good. I wish other paragraphs (e.g., Tobacco Cessation Services, Opioid substitution therapy) had the same level of data.
- 3. I would reconsider the order of paragraphs. For example, you may want to place the tobacco quitline services paragraph next to the tobacco cessation services paragraph.
- 4. The formatting makes it appear as though "training," "capacity building," and "staff pattern" sections are subsumed under the toxicology laboratory service section. Similar to what was mentioned in point #3, reconsider the order. I would place these sections earlier before you mention specific services or clinics.
- 5. The tables contain too much information and are not referred to within the text.
