1. The first paragraph is difficult to read and does not orient the reader to the topic of the article. Perhaps provide a definition of an addiction research center or how it has evolved over time (as is written in the third paragraph).
2. The data provided within the "community out-reach follow-up services:" paragraph is very good. I wish other paragraphs (e.g., Tobacco Cessation Services, Opioid substitution therapy) had the same level of data.
3. I would reconsider the order of paragraphs. For example, you may want to place the tobacco quitline services paragraph next to the tobacco cessation services paragraph.
4. The formatting makes it appear as though "training," "capacity building," and "staff pattern" sections are subsumed under the toxicology laboratory service section. Similar to what was mentioned in point #3, reconsider the order. I would place these sections earlier before you mention specific services or clinics.
5. The tables contain too much information and are not referred to within the text.
