Thank you for inviting me to review this work. It was a pleasure to read and try to understand the message of the authors and the scientific contribution of this work. The article presents an interesting study concerning the factors that influence the intention of mobile phone users to recycle their devices, with a focus on demographic differences in attitudes towards mobile phone recycling and stockpiling among men and women in the United Arab Emirates (UAE).

The main contributions of this paper indicate that there are significant demographic differences in attitudes and behaviors related to mobile phone recycling and stockpiling.

The paper is well organized, the references are up to date, the scientific conclusions are supported by the data. The method and the data used are adequate. The paper also presents a rich analysis and interpretation of the obtained results. However, the analysis is only descriptive and some correlation tests could be used. Another suggestion, in my opinion, is that the article could introduce, describe, some strategies used in other real cases to promote sustainable mobile phone recycling practices, like in a related work section.
