- 1- The researchers did not mention in the abstract the final result of the research.
- 2- The researchers didn't discuss the existence of problems between the explanatory variables, such as the problem of multicollinearity between the variables?
- 3 In the practical aspect, 4 models were chosen, while the research talks about choosing variables! The importance of building these models after selecting the variables must be mentioned.
- 4- The researchers mentioned the following statement (Note that the model with selected candidate variables in at least 15% contain all 12 variables) does it mean that this model contains all variables? Or did all models contain 12 variables?
- 5- After choosing the best model, the researchers did not show the contribution of each variable to the model?

In conclusion, this paper is considered good in terms of presenting the topic, using the selection of variables in the case of rare data, and choosing the type of data.
