

Review of: "The Political Ecologies of the Tonle Sap: Global, Regional and National Framework for Conservation and Development"

The submitted manuscript examines conservation concerns pertaining to Cambodia's Tonle Sap Lake and the Mekong River.

There are a few issues with readability that might be quickly fixed to create an extremely useful article. Below I list some specific aspects that should be reviewed:

The introduction is quite brief and for the reader who does not know about the specific problem, it is difficult to get into the topic.

Various species are named but no scientific names are provided, lending to confusion in interpretation

The excessive use of abbreviations makes some paragraphs unintelligible.

The symbols of the units should be written correctly, according to the International System.

The conclusions of the paper are somewhat vague and impractical and the research results are not entirely convincing.

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
