Review of: "Visitor Capture Metrics: Research Note on a Six-year Correlation Analysis of Provincial Tourists and Museum Visitors"

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Although in general the work is well-written and presented, I have two main criticisms about the work:

• It's not really clear what the overall goal of the paper is. Is it to demonstrate a correlation between tourism numbers and museum visitor numbers? If so, why is that interesting or useful? Isn't it to be expected? The paper doesn't really provide a motivation or reasoning for the analysis done, what the implications are, or what it could be used for.

Although this is acknowledged, the sample size is very small as each time series only has 6 data points
(yearly from 2018 to 2023); I'm not sure that much can be said about the data with such a small sample.

To conclude, I would say that the work is very descriptive and simple, and it's not clear what the contribution to the literature is.
