

## Review of: "Bisphosphonate-Related Osteonecrosis of the Jaws Treated with Platelet-Rich Plasma: Preliminary Results from a Case Series"

Materials and Methods.

Patient Selection. Please, report In which time interval were patients enrolled and provide inclusion and exclusion criteria.

The authors should also provide some information about treated patients. It could be useful to readers adding the underlying disease for which patients received bisphosphonates and the type of bisphosphonate.

Preparation of Plasma Formulation.....The 1 mL above the buffy coat, which presents the highest platelet and growth factor concentrations, was identified as fraction 2 (F2), whereas the next 2 mL above F1 was named fraction 1 (F1). I really do not understand if the volume of the recovered plasma was 2 or 3 ml.

Clinical Follow-Up Examination.

It could be useful to readers that authors provide additional information on the percentage of response at each follow up time. I can image that a patient could have no pain but still presence of non-complete healing or swallowing.

Discussion and references.

The most recent cited study about the PRP use in BJON dates 2012. Also the reference 25, listed as in press, has been published in 2012. Many studies have been subsequently published and the bibliography should be updated and adequately discussed.

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
