

Review of: "A New Record of *Elymnias Caudata* Butler, 1871 (Insecta: Lepidoptera: Nymphalidae) from Nagpur in Central India"

Basically, the introduction does not provide information that allows us to see the relevance of the *Elymnias* record in this new locality. I believe the introduction should give more data on previous reports in nearby localities, the life cycle, and its correspondence with the time of year, etc. All that text currently in the introduction could be better placed in the "Discussion" or "Comments" section.

The text indicates the first record of *Elymnias caudata* in Nagpur for the first time, expanding the distribution range of this species. I believe a review of this previous distribution should be given to understand the relevance of this record. Consider the "Synoptic Catalogue of the Butterflies of India" by Varshney & Smetacek (2015).

The location map of the new record could be improved by adding the localities with previous records of the species.
