- 2. The research gap has been defined narrowly.
- 3. The discussion should be rather organized around arguments, avoiding simply describing details without providing much meaning. A real discussion should also link the findings of the study to theory and literature.
- 4. Your storyline in the results section (and conclusion) is hard to follow. Moreover, the conclusions reached are really far from what manufacturing units can infer from the empirical results.
- 5. Conclusion has been delineated scarcely.
- 6. Correct typo errors/spaces in the manuscript. The language of the paper needs careful proofreading. The paper should be rejected if the authors are unaware of the revision and language.

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
