1. The abstract needs to be specific by indicating purpose, research design, findings, implications, and conclusion.
2. The research gap has been defined narrowly.
3. The discussion should be rather organized around arguments, avoiding simply describing details without providing much meaning. A real discussion should also link the findings of the study to theory and literature.
4. Your storyline in the results section (and conclusion) is hard to follow. Moreover, the conclusions reached are really far from what manufacturing units can infer from the empirical results.
5. Conclusion has been delineated scarcely.
6. Correct typo errors/spaces in the manuscript. The language of the paper needs careful proofreading. The paper should be rejected if the authors are unaware of the revision and language.
