- 2. My opinion is positive regarding the admission of the article to be published, although I recommend some improvements before launching a final version of the article.
- 3. In concrete terms, in point number 5 of the article, I strongly recommend explaining the potential benefits of PPP in human resources, and also explaining more deeply the potential limitations identified. I think it is very important to strengthen the research and contribution of the article. In its actual version, the benefits and limitations are enumerated but not explained. It is important to explain clearly why they are considered benefits and limitations.
