1. Interesting way of framing topic. good topic too. Appreciate for your effort to fill such a methodological gap. Readable and clear as well. Thank you.
2. I have some technical suggestions. But if think my suggestion is not appropriate you can keep yours.
3. Introduction part... first sentence ... the pronoun (...., "they" outlined...) is not clear. Who are those referred as "they" ?
4. The abbreviation "FEMA" appeared for the first time and not defined a priori. Define it first and you can use the short then.
5. Introduction part, second paragraph, in text citation, you used (St.Cyr,2005). St. for short is what? You mean saint? If so, not appropriate in academic writings. Similarly you used "Dr. Rogers...". I prefer not write this way. In general, titles of Authors are not mentioned in text. Not appropriate by the same reason.
6. At the paragraph you mentioned self-regulation theory for the first time, the second line from below, you misplaced "the" as "same the behavior." Thus, use "the same behavior". You can see it below from the full sentence (bold and underline). *"According to the theory, self-regulation consists of three main elements stages; self-monitoring, setting realistic goals, and modification. SRT proposes that a person deliberately monitors his/her own behavior and evaluates what effect it has of them. If the desired or targeted effect is realized, the person continues with **same the behavior**, but if the desired or targeted effect is not realized, the person changes that behavior (Muraven & Baumeister, 2000)."*
7. On construct 7, "sense of Responsibility" shall be written as "sense of responsibility" or "Sense of Responsibility". Capitalization uniformity problem.
8. put the figure for PBM in one single page for good readability. Is full part is missed when it jumped to the next page.
9. On page 11, line 6, in the sentence *"In order to test it through a survey instrument, the size of the survey can become overwhelming (ly) very fast, especially when more than one behavior is being investigated."* Use the adverb form of "overwhelming" as *"overwhelmingly very fast..."*.
