I have the following points for enhancement though: 1) the title might be rehashed to clearly reflect the content, 2) the introduction does not define the objectives and the extent of the paper. This is necessary so that readers would know the extent and direction of the paper and 3) once the goals and objectives are set, organizing the different subtopics can just flow smoothly.
