

Review of: "Factors Associated with Contraceptive Use Among Migrant Female Head Porters in the Kumasi Metropolis"

The explores the determinants of contraceptive use among an underprivileged group (migrant female head porters) in Ghana. The research problem is well explained. I have two comments that could improve the study.

- 1. The paper's contribution is not explicit. How different is it from existing works (e.g., Alatinga et al., 2021; Avissah et al., 2018)?
- 2. Is the dependent variable use of any method (traditional or modern) of contraception? Condom use seems to fits the STI prevention narrative best. A subsection describing the statistical strategy used might help readers understand how the dependent variable was measured.
- 3. The results presentation/description could be improved.
