The study is good and relevant to the nursing profession, however, the article does not seem to be ready for publication in its current form.

Here is why:

The mixed method indicated in the abstract is not in line with the content presented. I suggest that authors only concentrate on the methodology that produced the findings they are reporting about.

The introduction is lacking information related to the problem which necessitated the study.

The methodology section should include detailed information of the research design, population, sampling method and sample size.

The trustworthiness of the study should be discussed.

Data collection tools should be specified (open-ended or close-ended questionnaires)
