I think the article could be enriched by including two interesting aspects:

On the one hand, I suggest a methodological description section. He claims that the information was collected through direct field visits and from knowledgeable seniors in and around the villages where Ms. Pillai is located. You should introduce a section in which you describe the procedure carried out, number of interviews conducted, people interviewed, discourse analysis method used, etc.

On the other hand, and given the parallelism between the historical origins of the nursing profession and the social work profession, the historical division between both professions should be commented on, at what time and to what facts it is due that the professions were divided, and dedication to one profession or another.
